Punjab to have a Varsity in each district

The Punjab government has recently established Punjab Higher Education Council [PHEC] with an aim to ensure uniform policies of student intake, fee structure, examination systems and quality control mechanism.

Disparity among public as well as private universities of the province related to student intake, fee structure, examination system, legislation, statutes, rules, and regulations had always been a great concern of stakeholders as these areas seemed to be ignored by the federal government's Higher Education Commission (HEC). The council will also formulate policies, guidelines and priorities of higher education institutions.

Punjab Higher Education Council (PHEC) aims at establishing at least one university or sub-campus of a university at each district headquarters during the next five years.

HEC recognizes 2 Institutions

At present, the PHEC has representatives from all public sector universities of the province while private universities have only four members. Out of these, two are permanent members and two are elected.

The Higher Education Commission (HEC) has given Recommendation Letter / No Objection Certificate for grant of charter in private sector to Iqra National University, Peshawar and the Global Institute, Lahore.

The NOCs have been granted upon clearance of feasibility report followed by inspection of academic, financial and physical infrastructure in relation to meeting criteria requirements.

Working without a goal is just like working for nothing. Setting a goal will definitely help you to plan your life and you will work for just one thing: your goal in life.

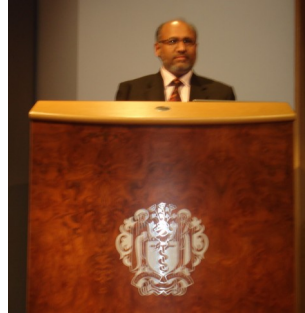

USAID / HEC Master's and Ph.D. Scholarships

Master's Scholarship

This program funds graduate study in the United States for a Master's degree program. The program is funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

All disciplines are eligible, except for clinical medicine, with priority given to Education, Educational Management, Agriculture, Health, Teaching of English, Journalism, and fields related to economic development. Eligible candidates will have a either a four-year bachelor's degree or a bachelor's and Master's combination totaling 16 years of formal education from an accredited university. Recent graduates are strongly encouraged to apply except MBA applicants, who require 3 years of work experience.

Ph.D. Scholarship

This program funds graduate study in the United States towards a Ph.D. degree. This may be coursework and/or research towards a Ph.D. or an entire

program. Funding for this program is provided by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) of the Government of Pakistan as well as USAID.

Eligibility Criteria

- Pakistani citizens with strong academic histories in all disciplines, except Clinical medicine.
- Work experience in teaching, research, or the public sector in Pakistan is highly desirable.
- Eligible applicants will have a Master's or M.Phil or comparable degree (a minimum of 18 years of formal education) from a recognized university.

Who is ineligible

Persons with a dual U.S./Pakistan nationality or who have a spouse, parent, fiancée, or child over 18 years of age who is a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.

Employees of the Fulbright organization or the U.S. Department of States and

their spouses, fiancées, siblings, dependants, children and parents.

For programs funded by their agencies employees of USAID or the HEC and their spouses, fiancées, siblings, dependants, children and parents are ineligible.

Deadline: 18 May 2010

Requirements

- Minimum score of 300 is required on each section of the GRE examination
- High level of fluency in spoken and written English.

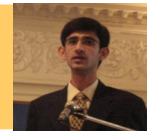

Economics — Where 'they' shape the Future

Economics is the branch of social science that deals with the production, distribution and consumption of resources i.e goods and services. In other words Economics is the study of human efforts to satisfy unlimited wants with limited resources which have alternate uses.

Economists:

- Collect, Compile, and analyze data to monitor economic growth
- Prepare reports including tables and charts, on research results (For this purpose they use computers extensively)
- Forecast market trends, applying mathematical models and statistical techniques.
- Research a wide variety of issues relating to economic growth/macro economic stability including Saving, Investment, Employment, Poverty, Social Services, Exchange Rates, Interest Rates, Energy Costs, and Taxes.
- work out policies and plans to solve economic problems
- Advise public and private agencies, on economic relationships among different players in the economy and suggest action plans for future.
- Advise policy makers in main areas such as macroeconomic stability, distributive justice,

resource mobilization, emanating challenges from domestic and external front for making policies like deregulation of industries, the effects of tax cuts on the budget deficit, and the effectiveness of imposing tariffs on imported goods etc.

- Also analyze data on employment trend in order to predict future spending needs.

Work Environment

Economists have structured work schedules. They often work alone, writing reports, preparing statistical charts. They may also be an integral part of a research team. Mostly work under pressure of deadlines and tight schedules.

Specializations

Many economists specialize in a particular area of economics, although general knowledge of basic economic principles is essential.

- Macroeconomics
- Industrial economics
- Labor economics
- International economics
- Econometrics

Many economists apply these areas of economics to health, education, agriculture, urban and regional economics, law, history, energy, the envi-

ronment, or other issues. Most economists are concerned with practical applications of economic policy.

NUST Undergraduate Admissions-2010

- The registration of NUST entry test for Undergraduate Programmes - fall 2010 will commence from **15 March 2010** and the last date is 30th April 2010.
- Entrance Exam will be conducted on 19 & 20 June 2010.
- Hard copies of prospectus for different programmes will be available for study/reference from designated branches of Askari Bank in major cities of Pakistan on payment, if required.

Ineligibility Criteria

Candidates with following deficiencies are not eligible to apply for admission test of NUST UG Programmes:-

- Have less than 60% marks in Matric or equivalent exam.
- Candidates applying on the basis of Intermediate part-I
- Less than 60% marks in Intermediate part-I
- Failed/not appeared in any subject in Intermediate part-I

- Candidates applying on the basis of Intermediate part-II or complete FA/FSc
- Less than 60% marks in complete FA/FSc
- Have less than 60% marks in O/A levels/equivalent exams as per equivalence certificates issued by IBCC.
- Does not have valid O/A level equivalence certificates issued by IBCC at the time of applying to NUST.
- FSc Pre-Medical candidates desirous to apply for Engineering programs but have not qualified and don't possess valid result of additional mathematics subject at the time of applying to NUST.
- Diploma holders are not eligible to apply for any undergraduate program.

Note:

Prospective candidates desirous to apply for UG Admissions for session 2010 are advised to get their CNIC or Registration B form from NADRA as this number is mandatory to proceed with the registration process.

It is also announced that PHEC would also introduce three streams in college education, namely centres of excellence, community colleges and public-private partnership. The most vibrant colleges would be given the status of the centre of excellence and four year graduation and market-oriented subjects would be introduced in these centers. While in community colleges, two-year graduation and technical subjects would be introduced and provision of adequate infrastructure would also be ensured in such colleges. Under the public-private partnership, proposal for commerce education in second shift is under consideration.

A Pakistani Young Scholar Publishes 7 papers in One Year

A PhD Scholar Shafillullah Khan, who is pursuing his studies at the School of Engineering and Design, Brunel University UK under HRD Scholarships from Kohat University of Science and Technology (KUST), has published seven papers in high impact international journals in a short span of one year.
